

Northeast Equestrian Series

The Northeast Equestrian Series (NES) is a schooling show series located on Long Island. The series is founded on the principle of bringing the local horse community together through safe competition, comradery, and horse/rider development. The horse show divisions are hosted at the following equestrian facilities; Hidden Pond Stables, Bohemia Equestrian Center (managed by Islip Horseman's Association), Old Field Farm, and Country Farms. All registered participants in Northeast Equestrian Series divisions are be eligible to compete at the NES Finals held at Old Field Farm each fall. NES riders and horses are also eligible for year end awards based on the accumulation of points throughout the show season. The celebration of the horses, riders and awards is held during the Annual Northeast Equestrian Series Banquet.

General Information / Rules & Regulations

- 1. Riders must compete in a minimum of **four** shows; **one** at each facility to be eligible for a year end award.
- 2. Riders wishing to be eligible for a year end award with Northeast Equestrian Series are required to pay a \$10 fee at each show attended **per division** in order for points to be counted.
- 3. Points are equally valued at each show. 1st-7pts, 2nd-5pts, 3rd-4pts, 4th-3pts, 5th-2pts, and 6th-1pt
- 4. Trainers, coaches and riders are to use discretion when choosing divisions in order to ensure fairness to all participants.
- 5. Horse and rider combinations are not restricted to showing in the same divisions for no more then two years.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Classes offered herein which are covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule unless stated otherwise.
 Points won at these shows will count toward the High Score awards.
- Country Farms Equestrian Center and all personnel and entities connected thereto shall in no case be held liable or responsible for any loss or damage to animal, person, or property which may occur for any reason, and this is a condition of entry upon the show grounds.
- All fees must be paid and entry blanks signed as required prior to the giving out of any numbers. REFUNDS WITH VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE ONLY.
- Riders must wear proper riding attire. Approved protective headgear must be in place when riding anywhere in the show grounds. Martingales allowed in the grass arena. Trotting permitted in all over fences classes in the grass arena.
- Warm-up. The warm-up fee is \$5.00 which must be paid prior to entering the ring. All riders must wear hard hats. Up to 10 riders will be allowed at a time for 10 minutes. Any rider wishing to reenter the ring may do so time permitting for an additional fee of \$5.00.
- Classes with insufficient entries will be cancelled or combined.

 Management reserves the right unto itself to cancel, combine, run sweepstakes, or substitute classes at its discretion.
- No dogs allowed.
- Pre-entries must be received by the Thursday prior to show date, no later than 5:00 pm.
- Pre-entry fees: \$20.00 per class. Post-entry fees: \$25.00 per class.
- Management reserves the right to add or change Judge if necessary.
- Management may elect to use a posted jumping order if necessary
 in the event that a posted jumping order is used, rides will be
 determined on a rotational basis. Back to back rounds are
 encouraged where available. If posted jumping orders are not used,
 the one minute rule to enter the ring will be strictly enforced.

Hunter Seat Equitation Divisions

LEADLINE- Open to riders 8 and under who have not shown in any classes requiring riders to walk, trot and canter. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division.

1. Leadline: Walk- ask a question

2. Leadline: Walk/Trot

3. Leadline: Walk/Trot/2 point at a walk

PRE-SPECIAL BEGINNER: Open to riders 12 and under who have recently started trotting independently. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division. Diagonals count but riders can get assistance in getting them.

4. Pre-Special: Walk/Trot

5. Pre-Special: Walk/Trot - 2 point

6. Pre-Special: Walk/Trot/ Cavaletti pole

SPECIAL BEGINNER: Open to riders under 18 who have not competed in a higher division. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division. Leads not to count.

7. Special: Walk/Trot

8. Special: Walk/Trot/Individual canter

9. Special: Walk/Trot/cavaletti pole or Single Cross rail

SHORT STIRRUP- Open to riders 12 and under who have not shown over fences 18" in this or any previous (schooling /rated) show season. Riders cannot cross enter into any division at this show except cross rail hunters. Simple changes are allowed.

10. Short Stirrup: Walk/Trot

11. Short Stirrup: Walk/Trot/Canter (No more than 4 to canter at once)

12. Short Stirrup: X-Rails (trotting permitted)

BEGINNER- Open to riders under 18 who have not shown over fences greater than 18" in this or previous (schooling/rated) show seasons. Riders cannot cross enter into any division at this show except Cross Rail Hunter.

A Section Junior B Section Adult 18 & older

13. Beginner: Walk/Trot

14. Beginner: Walk/Trot/Canter (No more than 7 to canter at once)

15. Beginner: X-Rails (trotting permitted)

ALL AGE 2" Equitation-Open to junior and adult riders who have not shown in any division in this or previous (schooling/rated) show season that required showing over fences higher that 2'. Simple changes allowed.

16. AAE: Walk/Trot/Canter

17. AAE: Over Fences 2' with change of direction

18. AAE: Over Fences 2' with change of direction

- **PRE- MINI /ADULT EQUITATION-**Open to all riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. Simple changes allowed.
- 19. Mini P H A: To be run in accordance with current PHA Equitation; fences not to exceed 2'6".
- 20. Mini Medal: To be shown over a course of not less than 8 obstacles not exceeding 2'6". Two changes of direction. Judge can call back to test top 4 riders.
- 21. Mini Maclay: To be shown over a course of not less than 8 obstacles not exceeding 2'6". Two changes of direction. The flat phase will include a walk, trot and canter. The under saddle performance shall count 50 percent.
- **ADAPTIVE RIDER DIVISION-**Offered to riders with a diagnosed disability. To be performed independently or with the aid of a "spotter". May not cross enter to any other division in the show series.
- 22. Walk Tot Equitation- Judged on rider's skills. Diagonals count- but Judges will allow coaches and "spotters" to help riders with finding the correct one.
- 23. Walk Trot Hunters- Judged on suitability and compatibility of horse and rider.
- 24. Course- can be done at the trot or canter- Riders and trainers may choose a cavaletti or cross rail course.

Jumper Division

PUDDLE JUMPER-Open to any horse or pony. Fences 2'0" - 2'3" with change of direction.

- 25. Timed First Jump Off: To compete over designated course in a time allowed. Major faults to count. USEF Rules apply.
- 26. Timed First Round: Timed first round over designated course, major faults to count. USEF rules apply.
- 27. Timed First Jump Off: To compete over designated course in a time allowed. Major faults to count. USEF Rules apply.

IHA,HPS,OFS,CFS, JUMPER-Open to any horse and ponies. Fences 2'6"-with changes of direction.

- 28. Timed First Jump Off: To compete over designated course in a time allowed. Major faults to count. USEF Rules apply.
- 29. Timed First Round: Timed first round over designated course, major faults to count. USEF rules apply.
- 30. Timed First Jump Off: To compete over designated course in a time allowed. Major faults to count. USEF Rules apply.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Classes to be judged on the

horse's performance, soundness, manners, consistency and suitability to purpose.

CROSS RAIL HUNTER- Open to horses and ponies who are not entered in any other division with fences higher than 18 inches. Simple changes allowed

COUNTRY FARMS SERIES AWARD

Series awards will be given out at the end of the season. To be eligible for our awards, riders must compete in at least two shows in the same division. Riders do not have to compete on the same horse. Points not to count in classes with less than three riders.

Directions to Country Farms

Heading Eastbound on the LIE: Exit 65. Take service road straight, going past the 1st light at Horseblock Road to the second light which is Bellport Avenue. Make left on to Bellport Avenue. Follow Bellport Avenue over LIE light and past stop sign. Continue straight on Bellport to Country Farms on left side. Drive up to the middle of the gates and they will open automatically.

Heading Westbound on the LIE: Exit 66. Continue straight through first light staying on service road. Take service road to the second light which is Bellport Avenue and make a right. Stay on Bellport Avenue past the next stop and go straight to Country Farms on left. Drive up to the middle of the gates and they will open automatically.
